



## **Team Parent Responsibilities**

Thank you for volunteering to serve as a Team Parent. Your participation enables the coaches to focus on duties such as teaching skills and coordinating practices. By volunteering your time, you improve the quality of our league and your child's experience. If you have questions regarding either your responsibilities as a Team Parent or Concession Stand duties, please feel free to contact the Big Willow Concession Stand Managers listed below.

As a Team Parent your responsibilities include:

1. Concession Stand Duties: Hand out a copy of the Concession Stand Requirements to all of the families on your team.
2. Read and understand the Concession Stand Requirement Handout, so you can answer questions from the parents on your team.
3. Call parents the week, or the day, before their assigned Concession Stand shift to remind them to work.
4. Collect funds for Concession Stand "treat" tickets from the players' parents. It is customary that each player receives a ticket for a treat at the concession stand after each game.
5. Assign an adult to operate the scoreboard for all home games. Scoreboards are used at the Juniors, Farm, and Majors levels.
6. Coordinate Big Willow Night at the MN Twins game registration. Teams that turn in their registration sheet together can be seated together.
7. Distribute league communications (Opening Day details, field clean-up, re-scheduled games, playoff schedules, etc.)
8. Organize team party at the end of the season (if team agrees).
9. Pick up and distribute trophies at the end of the season.
10. Other duties agreed with your coach.
